



Anzac Day Doubles Championships

The Inverleigh Disc Golf Club is proud to be hosting the Vic Open Anzac Day Doubles. The doubles format is Best Throw. The event will be played on the Inverleigh White Course on Thursday April 25th at 9am.

We are extending the course with 3 extra bonus holes to make 21 holes in total to allow for some extra teams. There is still only a maximum of 42 team spots available, so be sure to register soon.

The doubles is not PDGA sanctioned and will be scored using Metrix.

Cost:

First Place Division 1: \$250 cash per team

Second Place Division 1: \$100 cash per team

First Place Division 2: \$250 cash per team

Second Place Division 2: \$100 cash per team

Third Place Division 2: \$25 Flying Disc Store Voucher per team member

Team Format:

Division 1: Team combined rating of 1801 or above

Division 2: Team combined rating of 1800 or below

Registration:

Payment is to be made at the time of registration.

Note: Your spot is NOT secured until your payment is made

Sign In & Players Meeting:

All teams must sign in at the clubhouse before 8:30am.

All teams must attend the players meeting at 8:40am

Doubles Format:***Best Throw***

Both team members throw from the teeing area. The team then chooses which of the two positions to play from for the next throw. Both team members throw from the chosen lie and so on until a team completes a hole when either team member's holes out.

Minimum 10 Tee Shots per Team Member

Teams must select at least 10 drives (tee throws) from each team member. The extra 11th drive available is a bonus and can be used by either player on the team.

Other Rules:

If a team picks up a thrown disc before a lie has been chosen, the team may not choose that throw. If a team picks up both thrown discs without a lie having been marked, the second disc to have been picked up is replaced to its original position as agreed upon by the group, and the team must play from the resulting lie.

If one team member is absent, late, or ceases play, the other team member may play, but no throws are made on behalf of the missing team member. A late team member may join play only between holes.
